This residential is open to Year 12 or Level 3 (Year 1) students who meet our academic and Widening Participation eligibility criteria (see overleaf).

During the 4 day programme, you will:

- → receive information and guidance around the topics of student finance and the cost of living as a student
- have the opportunity to socialise with others and meet like-minded individuals through a variety of social activities
- stay in student halls
- → plan a meal on a budget
- tour the city of Southampton with a current student
- experience teaching and research within a subject area
- find out where our graduates ended up after they studied at UoS

To be eligible, applicants must be taking relevant and required qualifications and subjects in their chosen taster degree subject.

Applicants must also meet at least one of the following Widening Participation criteria:

- → Current home postcode shows that you live in an area with low levels of progression to Higher Education. (Postcodes within the lowest 2 POLAR4 or TUNDRA (MSOA) quintiles: Q1 or Q2). You can check your postcode for the measures on our webpage below.
- → Current home post code shows that you live in an area that falls within the lowest Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) quintile Q1.
- → In receipt of a 16-19 bursary or similar grant OR received Free School Meals after the age of 14.
- → Living or grew up in Local Authority care.
- → Are a Young Carer.
- → Are an estranged student.
