Any cultural, historical, political influences?)3. Key Looks & Pieces (highlight standout garments/signature styles, any showstoppers?)4. Colour Palette & Fabric choices (Which colours dominated, materials used, innovational fabrics?)5. Styling & Accessories (Hair/makeup/shoes etc, does it enhance or contrast clothing? Recurring or symbolic accessories?)6. Casting & Diversity (Any notable models, celebrities or unexpected figures? How diverse was the cast?)7. Trends & Take Aways (are elements from past seasons being continued or reimagined? Does it reflect a larger cultural or fashion shift?)8. Atmosphere & Presentation (how did the runway setting, music or choreography enhance the show?)9. Critical Insight (Was the collection successful, cohesive, risky, safe? What does it suggest about the brand's future direction?)
